Saco, ME Est. 1948 Hello, neighbors! The Kinney Shores Association wishes to welcome you to Kinney Shores and to say how pleased we are that you have chosen our beautiful seaside community for your residence or rental.

The Kinney Shores Association (KSA) was formed in 1948 to promote cooperation and to build relationships among its residents--both seasonal and year-round. KSA's objective is to maintain the character and quality of our community, both through the voluntary activities of its members and by keeping abreast of issues that concern Kinney Shores.

Kinney Shores lies within the City of Saco and is subject to its laws and regulations. Among those that directly affect us are:

- 1. <u>Fireworks and Fires</u>—Fireworks of any kind are prohibited on the beach or on any other public or private property. Fires are prohibited on the beach. Both these rules dramatically reduce the terrible destruction fires and fireworks can cause to homes and to our protective dune grass.
- 2. <u>Dogs</u>—During the summer months, July and August, dogs on the beach must be leashed between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and dog waste must be removed from the beach and other public areas
- 3. Noise Loud noises that are annoying or disturb the peace, comfort or safety of others are prohibited prior to 7:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m.

Finally, we ask that we all be good neighbors and leave our beautiful beach the way we found it. *Please make sure to familiarize your family, guests and tenants with this information.*

Volunteers take turns throughout the summer watering and caring for the planters at the North and South ends of Kinney Shores. The Association arranges for the boardwalks to be cleaned and, maintains the doggie waste bags at several beach entrances. The Association also keeps up with locally-focused topics of interest, including the environment and wildlife protection.
